Demonstration: Many years of experience painting in plein air helped Mary develop a simple process to make landscape painting easy and enjoyable no matter what the weather or the circumstances provide. She will demonstrate how she chooses a subject, decides on the design of the painting, determines values, keys the painting and does all her thinking and prep work before she even puts a brush on the canvas. She will show how making decisions before she starts painting frees her up to be loose and expressive while painting. Drawing, line, shape, value, color temperature, chroma, surface quality and brush work will be discussed.

This streamlined simple process can be applied to all wet media: oil, acrylic, gouache and watercolor.
