April 2024 Newsletter

We also normally host a "drop in" at the Rec Center on the nonmeeting Mondays from 10:30 am – 12:30 pm for those who would like to get together to paint, create & chat. Please let Ellen (pastelpainter84@gmail.com) know if you might like to join on those Mondays; she has been trying to email around before hand to see who plans to attend, which helps us in planning.



April 2024 Meeting Notes

- Heather gave the membership report: 42 renewed, 5 new, 1 returning, and 21 haven't responded
- Kathy gave treasurer's report
- Heather met with the Executive Director of the Ocean Park Association who was extremely grateful for SBA's \$1000 contribution to the Ocean Park Disaster Relief fund. This will be in their next newsletter. The impact across the town has been dramatic and at the library, the entire children's section was lost and the floors will need to be redone.
- Kathy reported on the summer shows and spots are continuing to fill (all 3 shows were essentially full last year) and she's extending the deadline for registration to May 28(?) since she will be away. She's also been in touch with Saco and Biddeford Savings for the purchase prizes and people's choice awards of \$300 each. SBA will have its own tent with a new banner at the August show to allow members who don't have enough art inventory for their own tent to display a number of pieces. Kathy will send around the registration for that in late May/early June.
- There was discussion about SBA branding around our shows—perhaps placards, tent cards, brochures and/or flags that would signify which exhibitors are "proud members of SBA" and encourage attendees to "ask me about SBA." At the very least we will be working on a brochure or cards that each member could have at their booth and perhaps incorporate further ideas in the future.
- A larger discussion was had about refreshing our branding and design more generally, namely the SBA logo and the website.
 - Christine referenced the need for the logo to be much more user friendly for our needs and easier to reproduce across a variety of formats, printed and online. The website also would benefit from a redesign with more <u>design</u> sensibilities given we are artists and to build in some features like a gallery of member art, etc.

- The suggestion was made that we host a contest for members to submit new logo designs by May 3 for voting at the May 13 meeting. A \$100 gift certificate for art & craft supplies would be awarded to the member with the winning entry.
- Kailleigh & Christine were appointed as a design committee to help orchestrate the above projects.
- A detailed email was sent to members on April 9 with all the details on the contest and some examples
 of the design parameters. The text component of that email is also provided below.
- Kailleigh talked about the Saco Main Street event (more in the events section below), which is being juried this year with an attempt to refocus the event on fine arts. She suggested that SBA might consider a small sponsorship and a \$60 Friend level sponsorship was proposed and passed.
- Kathy mentioned other ways SBA has obtained visibility for the group and its shows, including ads/calendar listings through the OOB Chamber of Commerce, the Ocean Park Association booklet and the True Maine booklet in hotels/motels.
- Carry over from March meeting: Sylvia is stepping down from coordinating portrait sketching at the Libby Library in OOB, which is offered once a month for 3 hours from June to October. The sessions are free and open to the public and the library pays for a model to sit. Sylvia has talked to someone about potentially taking over for her as coordinator but if you are interested, please contact her at sgorch6648@gmail.com.

SBA Logo Design Contest – DEADLINE MAY 3

We are looking to redesign the SBA logo (the black & beige banner across the top of our website here: https://www.sacobayartists.org/). The old logo pays homage to our heritage along the coast of Saco Bay but has a number of limiting factors, primarily that it does not reproduce well for printing or in online venues like Facebook.

We would like to enlist the help of our members to CREATE a fresh take on our logo, so we are hosting a design "contest." With an eye for design (we are artists after all!), our new logo should highlight who we are and also meet some specific criteria to ensure that it is user-friendly for us across formats:

- 1) Our new logo will combine the Saco Bay Artists name with some graphic element
- 2) It will suggest our Saco Bay/seaside locale in some way, but doesn't need to be representational (could be abstract, interpretive, or just some hint!)
- 3) It can be organized to be stacked vertically or side-by-side horizontally
- 4) It will look attractive whether it's represented in color or black & white/greyscale; it could include full

saturation of a color and/or a shaded version/screen

- 5) It is optimized for a white background but can also be reversed as needed (white lettering on a dark background)
- 6) It is easily readable with clean, clear lines so that it will reproduce well even when small (the fencing in our current logo makes this almost impossible)
- 7) All or part of it could be used as a small icon for social media

Your design can be done digitally if you have a way to design in a software program but you can also create it on or in the medium of your choice (draw, paint, whatever) and submit an image— either taking a photo or scanning it. If you don't have a way to create and send an electronic image, please let Kailleigh know and we can find a way to take a digital photo of it. Kailleigh & Christine have been deemed the design committee and will create a short list of the strongest entries meeting the above criteria; those finalists will be voted on at our next meeting on May 13. The artist who submits the "winning" logo will receive a \$100 gift certificate for art & craft supplies. If the winning entry is not already in a digital format, we can have the graphic design done afterward. Heather also mentioned that Vistaprint has a free Logomaker tool (https://www.vistaprint.com/logomaker) and while you can play around with keywords to get different options, you can't upload your own designs or pictures.

Upcoming at the May 13 Meeting

Our program at our May 13 meeting will feature artist, Martha LaMarche, who works in oils, assemblage, and collage/multimedia. The timeless visual communication of the arts fascinates Martha: "I lose myself in the brushstrokes, color, composition and the awakening of the elusive flow." Her primary creative springboard is nature, but current events and the inner turmoils they spark also invite creative exploration.



In Martha's work, larger surfaces often promote movement and spontaneity and pair well with oil colors and other mediums. Her passion for subjects reveals itself in her organic movements with a variety of instruments. The resulting mark-making techniques create statements open to interpretation and introspection by viewers. She works with fastidious care, building layer by layer, to create a sophisticated, evolving surface patina, sometimes as smooth as silk, yet with depth; other times rough and thick with paint. In these many layered compositions, one layer informs the next... the way that each year of our lives informs the next.

When creating a series of works about a particular subject, Martha prefers to avoid working in a linear fashion. Instead, she finds that moving freely from one subject to the next creates greater opportunities for creative expression. With that pursuit, she can explore different subjects, and at times different styles that organically evolve to produce a number of complex interrelated themes. She calls it "the coalescence."
