## Ocean Park Button Contest Reminder

The buttons are made available at the July 4th parade (and afterward in the OPA office) for a donation to the Ocean Park Association.

The design should have some sort of July 4th theme and also have something to do with Ocean Park. The design needs to include "Ocean

Park Association" and "2013".

The buttons are 3" in diameter, so the artwork should be within a circle. The successful artwork in the past was 6-7" in diameter and was scanned to produce an electronic file used to create the buttons.

The deadline for submission of designs to SBA (Kathy Angel Lee) is **Monday, April 8.**

The Ocean Park Association will keep the winning artwork and will return the other submissions.

## SACO BAY ARTISTS to host Oil Pastel Demonstration

Saco Bay Artists will hold its monthly meeting featuring a Sennelier oil pastel demonstration by artist Jim Minet at 7 pm on Monday, April 8, at the Pines on Manor Street in Ocean Park.

This will be a product demonstration where participants will have an opportunity to try oil pastels, ask questions about their use and application, as well as mediums that can be used with them. Minet will demonstrate by

doing several small sketches showing how to use the product dry as well as mixed with odorless mineral spirits to create different effects.

A Long island resident, Minet has a web site at [www.jimminet.com](http://www.jimminet.com) and exhibits at Firefly Artists Gallery in Northport, NY. He said that Sennelier developed the oil pastel for Pablo Picasso, who was looking for something that he could

draw with on canvas or paper, that would perform similarly to paint but be less cumbersome.

**Summer Show Guidelines**

**GENERAL:** Dates for 2013 are Thursday, July 4; Saturday, August 3; and Saturday, August 31. Shows will be held from 9 AM to 4 PM on the Ocean Park Library lawn on Temple Avenue between West Grand and Seaside Avenues. Artists can set up starting at 6:30 AM and must remain set up until 4 PM.

**FIRST TIME EXHIBITORS:** If you are a first time exhibitor for the show, you must send in with your application a CD or 3-5 photographs of your work for jurying purposes.

**SPECIAL REQUESTS:** If you desire a particular space, please note your preference at the bottom of the application in the "Special Requests" section and efforts will be made to accommodate you. Space assignments will be emailed or mailed one week prior to the show.

**PARKING:** Since parking is limited, plan to arrive early and to stay until breakdown at 4PM. A parking pass will be provided the morning of the show.

**DISPLAYS/TENTS:** Artists must supply their own displays, which must be placed facing in and two feet from your closest neighbor's spot. Any tent and/or display cannot exceed 10 x 10 feet unless additional space is rented. All artists are to stay in their assigned spaces and if their displays exceed these specifications they will be asked to immediately change their display to fit.

**ARTWORK DISPLAYED:** Due to the relationship we have with the Ocean Park Association, we ask that no paintings of nudes be displayed. All work that is shown must be original works of fine art and not infringe on the copyright of others. **This is a fine art show and no crafts are permitted.** Reproductions of your originals are allowed and encouraged. Saco Bay Artists reserves the right to refuse any work not following the above guidelines.

Saco Bay Artists reserves the right to limit the number and type of media being displayed.

**FEES:** Fees are for each artist participating in the show, regardless of whether one shares a tent or has their own tent. Every artist showing work must register, be juried in and pay the entry fee.

Entry fee for Saco Bay Artist members: \$55

Entry fee for Non-members: \$90

**RAIN DATES/CANCELLATIONS:** Shows will be held rain or shine. All show fees are non-refundable.

**DUE DATE:** Applications for all three shows must be postmarked by **June 1, 2013**. Applications received after that date will be placed on a waiting list. If there are spaces still available for each show, assignments will be made on a first come/first serve basis.

**APPLICATION:** The attached application is for all three shows. Check the dates you are requesting and send your application and check to the address on the application.
