
# Saco Bay Artists

# **August 2023 Newsletter**

Our meetings are held monthly from March-December, usually on the second Monday of the month from 10:30 am -12:30 pm. The meeting location is the Saco Parks & Rec Center at 75 Franklin Street in Saco. OUR NEXT MEETING WILL BE ON MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 11, 2023 - ALL WELCOME. Masks are currently optional, so do whatever makes you comfortable.



We host a "drop in" at the Rec Center on the non-meeting Mondays from 10:30 am – 12:30 pm for those who would like to get together to paint, create, chat, etc. Please let Ellen (pastelpainter84@gmail.com) know if you might like to join on those Mondays; she has been trying to email around on Sundays to see who plans to attend, which helps us in planning.

# **August Meeting Minutes:**

- Ellen called the meeting to order and reviewed the treasurer's report.
- Heather's membership report noted 53 SBA members, including 4 new additions. There were a number of new faces in attendance at the meeting, so introductions were done around the room.
- Kathy gave an update on the success of the August show in Ocean Park, which had 29 registrants this year.
   The weather was perfect (this time!) and the show went well. Wade Harris was the judge and the winners were as follows (with his comments):
  - o Best in Show Philip Lamson for overall booth; consistent, high quality work
  - o First, Fine Art Pam Shockey for Lunch at the Harbor; paint quality, composition, color, strokes
  - o Second, Fine Art Richard Winslow for his paintings; paint quality, color, composition
  - Honorable Mention, Fine Art Rick Lang for booth; Rustic look with framing for all his work
  - o First Prize, Fine Craft Cheryl Goguen; color, texture and originality
  - Second Prize, Fine Craft Patti Wheeler for landscape in wool felt; texture of the piece
  - Honorable Mention Kathy Angel Lee for overall booth; variety, color
  - o Bill Edmunds Award Joe Rokowski for State Inspection Stickers; different/unique subject matter
  - Purchase Prize for People's Choice Credit Union to Pam Shockey
- The Saco Bay Artist tent was well received (see panorama photo below), although a recommendation was made to have a banner made for the tent with the SBA name, logo and web address. The motion was received and Heather and Nancy offered to work on this. There was also a suggestion to have the SBA tent at one or both of the other summer shows instead of just August.



- There is a good showing for the September show and Kathy talked to a number of artists around South Portland's Art in the Park who may be interested to participate.
- Further to SBA marketing, there was discussion about having SBA business cards or rack cards made with information about the organization. These could be handed out at shows and also stocked in community buildings around the area. A suggestion was made that perhaps the show cards that Kalleigh kindly produced could be updated with "evergreen" information about SBA.
- The Libby Library will be hanging an indoor art show for the month of September. 21 SBA artists are
  participating and Ellen has sent all the details separately, including artwork labels and required
  information. She and Sylvia will need help hanging from 6-7 pm on Thursday, August 31. Artists may bring
  3 works each, at least 2 of which will be hung (ideally all 3). Pick up will occur Thursday, September 28<sup>th</sup>
  between 6-7 pm.

### Carry over from prior meetings:

- Ellen and Sylvia met with Libby Library to discuss SBA being part of the OOB Fall Fest on Saturday, September 30. The aim is to promote local crafts and businesses to the residents of OOB. SBA is hoping to have two spaces, one of which would be a tent featuring art from our members.
- Monthly portrait sketching is again being offered at Libby Library and is taking place indoors. Participants
  can sketch or paint and the library pays to have a live model for each session (models needed!). The dates
  are the second Thursday of the month from 1:30-4:30 with two remaining sessions for the season: Sept 14
  and Oct 12. Sylvia (sgorch6648@gmail.com) can add people to the call list each month if they'd like a
  reminder.

#### August Demo by Gerard Bianco


During the August meeting, SBA member Gerard Bianco hosted a live watercolor painting demo for the group. Gerard works in both watercolor and oils and feels the former has positively influenced his work in the latter. He feels that practice is key for artists to succeed and also noted that composition, color mixing and using quality materials (such as Arches watercolor paper) are also very important. He uses 300 lb cold press paper because the smoothness allows for layering, whereas hot press offers transparency. When painting with watercolor, Gerard begins with a light sketch and then works from the top down and back to front. He uses masking fluid to preserve any white areas he needs to paint around. He likes to mix the colors he needs ahead of time so he has them ready and can work quickly. This also allows him to constantly adjust and shift colors which makes elements of the painting stand out. ### **Upcoming Demos**

Dwayne Turpin, woodcarver, is scheduled to speak at the September meeting. He'll be bringing tools to show and will demonstrate carving techniques. Dwayne started carving when he received his first knife in Boy Scouts but didn't get serious about it until he graduated from college. His early tools were a knife and sandpaper and he started relief carvings when he was on cruises in the U.S. Navy. In California he joined a woodcarver's group and there discovered the different blades available for carving. He has done numerous hiking sticks and recently started wood blocks for printing.

Ellen is seeking volunteers to host demos during our monthly SBA meetings in 2023...and you get paid for it too! You are encouraged to show us how you make your art, but if you prefer not to "perform," a demo related to your art/technique, tips of the trade, history/influencers, etc. would be just as valuable. Feel free to get creative!

#### SBA Leadership Roles and Needs

We have been incredibly fortunate to have such dedicated and talented members who have volunteered their time for SBA Chair and Committee positions over the years, but several of our current leaders have understandably expressed a desire to identify successors so they can pass the torch. - **SBA Finance**: David Steed has stepped back from his finance role due to other commitments. There is a need for someone to oversee the budget and work with the treasurer to develop the budget.
- **SBA Treasurer**: Lettie would like to transition out of the Treasurer role. This involves depositing checks, making payments, working with SBA's bank, tracking deposits and withdrawals from the various accounts, and working with the Finance person on budgeting.
